St Thomas Public School is affiliated to central board of secondary education and the medium of interaction is English. Our school possess 750 students 30 teaching and 10 non-teaching faculty. We have six school vans with support staff to various places. Our school is equipped with Kids Park, smart class rooms, library, full-fledged physics, chemistry, biology and computer labs and a big play ground.

JUNE

The academic year 2018 – 2019 began on 1st June 2018 with the opening ceremony conducted in our auditorium in the presence of honorable our school local manager Rev. Sr. Maria Vadakkedam.

On June 5th as a part of world environmental day celebrations, a special assembly was held with several programs related to the conservations of nature.
